

FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS

The following table (which continues through the last page) details all 45 MOHCD grants that have been recommended for renewal in fiscal year 2020-2021. All of these grants were previously funded by MOHCD in fiscal year 2019-2020. All of these grants were previously procured through a competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) process. However, given the sole source status of the provider, critical nature of the services and/or target population, and/or ongoing fund source, these projects did not require submission and selection through a RFP process to be recommended for funding in fiscal year 2020-2021. Agencies included in the following table should note the 9-month funding amount; that is the award recommendation for fiscal year 2020-2021. All recommendations are slated to start October 1, 2020, with grant terms that run through June 30, 2021.
