1. REQUEST FOR FINAL GAP FINANCING FOR TREASURE ISLAND PARCEL C3.1

Mercy Housing 82, L.P., a partnership formed by Mercy Housing California ("Mercy"), requests a total gap loan in the amount of up to \$33,452,317 for Treasure Island Parcel C3.1 (:TI-C3.1"), an affordable housing development with 71 supportive housing replacement units, 23 transition replacement units for Treasure Island Legacy Households, and 43 new affordable housing units for low-income families. The project received a California Housing Accelerator Fund ("Accelerator") Tier 1 award in the amount of \$55,601,514 on February 3, 2022. Pending approval of this final gap request, the project will be fully funded and will be able to start construction in May 2022.
