Homeownership SF is collaboration of several local non-profit housing counseling agencies working together to provide renter counseling, including eviction and tenant assistance. WITH THE NEW YEAR COMES.... ANNUAL INCOME RECERTIFICATION

As you know, BMR rentals provide housing opportunities for low- and moderate-income families who may not otherwise afford San Francisco rents. To ensure the continued success of the program, MOHCD works with property managers to annually income certify BMR households. When it's your turn, your property manager will ask you to:

- > Fill out the BMR application, and
- Provide household income documents.

Tip: Completing income documents and applications in their entirety will ensure the process runs quickly and smoothly.
